Our harvest should begin around the second week in July...but stay tuned for our announcement of berry availability. The price of our berries will not change again this year...that is 8 years without a price increase! Last year we sold out many times the day we picked.

The 2020 *berry subscription program* is now available. Thanks to the many of you who have purchased a subscription this year. This program entitles subscribers to a season discount by pre-purchasing 21 or 42 pints of fresh berries. Subscribers can then stop by weekly or anytime during the season to pick up their berries by using their punch card instead of cash. This program is very helpful to us since it shows your commitment to buying berries, sustaining our farm, and helping us with cash flow. It will also help provide a cashless payment system during our COVID restrictions. Check our web site for details and a form to sign up.
